



Expanded noughts and crosses

This game can be played by three or more players or teams. Each team should choose a symbol to represent themselves (for example, a star, a heart, or a smiley face).

Choose a square and say a sentence including the verb in the square. Your sentence must follow the verb – object – ‘to’ + infinitive structure, as discussed in *Grammar Challenge – Verb, Object, ‘to’ + Infinitive*.

If your sentence is grammatically correct, you can put your symbol on the square. You can win the game by making a line of three squares horizontally, vertically, or diagonally.
